Committee Reports:

- **Building & Grounds:**
 - Roof: No update.
 - Parking Lot: Board issued a letter to each tenant in the neighboring building demanding the removal of all vehicles during snow events or certain times at the risk of towing at owner's expense. Multiple attempts were made so speak to the landlord directly. Enough has improved that no further escalation is being considered at this time. Also, Gary M will purchase salt spreader for driveway and sidewalks.
- **Technology:**
 - Water Detection System: Rick C stated installation still pending.
 - Security Cameras: Rick C received quotes from Above All Telecom for two different exterior security camera configurations. Further refined quote to be requested and an additional quote will be sought from another company for a similar system.
- **Outreach:**
 - Snack Stash: No update.
 - Social Worker Intern Program: Kim B reported that she has met with various library directors throughout the county about implementation and scope of proposed program. Steve Bachman presenting same to Binghamton University for considered partnership.
- **Administration:**
 - School Tax: Budgetary needs over the past 10 years have increased about \$16,000 in operational costs, predominately in salary (rising minimum wage), utilities, and lending media. Kim B to draft school tax proposal for an additional \$15,000 annual increase.
