

Frederick City Md Apl 6th 1865

Dear Mother

I wrote to you this morning & told you that I was in the hospital & so I was at that time but when the Chief Surgeon came in he told me that he had not accommodations for officers & that it would be best for me to board in town if I could find a place. I can not get a place at a private house at present & shall board at the hotel for a while. The Renters in the house are very kind & do all that they can for me, so you see I am very well satisfied with it. The doctor told me to make an application for a leave for twenty days & I shall send that on in the morning. If I get that I shall have the privilege of staying at home untill I get well. Do not direct your letters as I Said in the other letter but direct to me at U.S. Hotel Frederick City Md do not put on the No. of the regt. Please remember me to all
