

Franklin La Feby 28th 1864

Dear Mother

We have had two mails this week & no letter from you. I guess that you forgot to write when the time came around. There is nothing more to write about now than there was the last time I wrote, only we are making preparations to move again. We shall probably go right back where we went last fall, only a great deal farther up. The report is that we are going up the red river as far as Shrevesport & that is almost to the Arkansas line. I wrote you last Sunday that I should probably have to go back to my Company but things have changed some since then & I think I shall stay where I am for the present. I would like to write you a good long letter but I am out of time and I'll halt here
