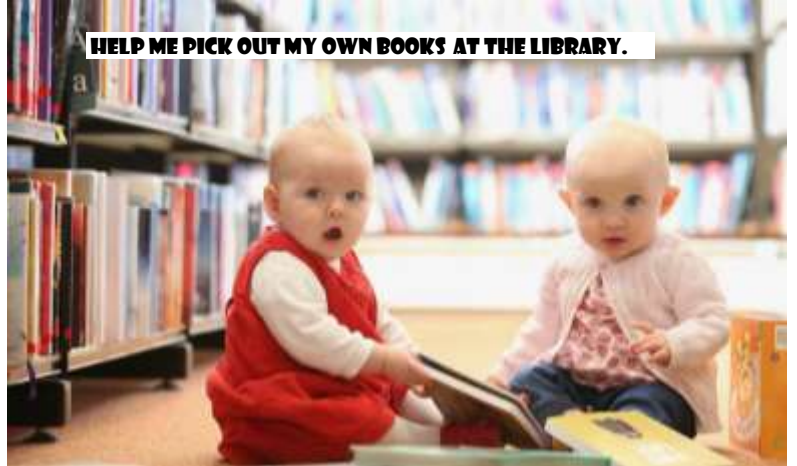

# Train Reading Activities

1. Choose a book that has a train in it. You can always search the library catalog on any topic to find books your child might like.
2. Read the book together.
3. Choose a page in the book and help your child point out different things. Ask “Can you show me the tree in the picture?” or “What color is this house?”
4. Sing Down by the Station together. Act out the words to the song, pulling on the whistle when you say toot toot, etc.
5. Show your child the picture of the train, then cut up the other copy of the train into an appropriate number of pieces for your child to put together like a puzzle. Help your child put together the puzzle, explaining how you know where the pieces go. Then mix up the puzzle and see if your child can put it together by herself.
