The Library's 3D Magic Pen (printing pens), are available to make three-dimensional objects in plastic.

- 1. The Library's 3D printers may be used for lawful purposes only. The public will not be permitted to use the Library's 3D printers to create material that is:
- Prohibited by local, state, or federal law.
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others (such use may violate the terms of use of the manufacturer)
- Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the Library environment
- In violation of another's intellectual property rights. For example, the printers will not be used to reproduce a material that is subject to copyright, patent or trademark protection.
- The 3D printing pens, will not be used to make weapons, or assorted other illegal items.
- 2. Priority is given to Richfield Springs Public Library cardholders.
- 3. The Library reserves the right to refuse any 3D printing request.
- 4. At this time, there is no charge for this service, unless the item is lost, or returned with damages, then the patron's account will be billed accordingly, full cost of the kit is \$150.00.
- 5. The Library is not responsible for any damage, or loss arising from the use of its 3D Printing Pens, nor for the functionality or quality of content produced with the 3D pens.
- 6. The Library requires supervision of any children while using the 3D printing pens by an appropriate, responsible adult.
- 7. This policy, adopted in September of 2020, will be reviewed every six months to allow for evaluation of the use of this technology by staff.
