For Creative Writing, the topic to work on will be Summer Plans, both of these programs are geared to all ages who are interested in writing and art.

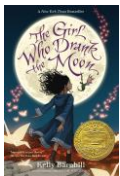
For the first Art Class, we will be working on Still Life Drawing. You can bring your own tools and materials, or we can provide them for you.

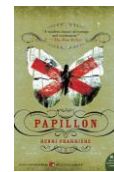
