Happy Holidays everyone! December has come upon us, it seems to have arrived faster this year than the past few. So many wonderful things to come in the new year. We are working on a couple of new collaborations, if you haven't already heard. With the Richfield Springs Central School, we are working on a new community based committee to help ensure the future reading skills of the area children. The Community Literacy Partnership – "Building a community of readers" has formed involving several groups and officials within the Richfield Springs School District to help bring the love of reading to all children in our area and ensure a successful transition into Kindergarten. Students from Richfield Springs Central School have created a new group in which they will be collaborating with us, Richfield Springs S.A.S (Students Adopting Seniors), students from the school formed this group, with the hopes "they might improve the social interaction between elderly community members and students in Richfield Springs to combat isolation." The students and I will be working on new programs to hold at the library and/or the school in which we will welcome members from the elderly community to take part in different social activities and we will also offer a tech night, where we will assist individuals to understand and use their technology, (such as computers(laptops), tablets, and smart phones). The S.A.S Group, won an award of \$3,000 which they will be providing to the Library for the purchase of a Cricut Machine, for use in the Teen & Adult Art Collective Group, and to help with the purchase of supplies for the machine. Teens and adults working together on art projects or assisting each other on their own projects is what the Teen & Adult Art Collective Group is all about!

Art Programming this month, will take place as follows: Kids Art Class will be on Tuesday, December 5th at 3:30 pm, and Tuesday, December 19th at 3:30 pm. The Teen & Adult Art Collective will be on December 5th at 6 pm and December 19th at 6 pm.

During the Teen & Adult Art Collective group meeting on December 5th, I will be demonstrating how to apply a photo to wood ornaments and glass bottles. This can be a great gift for the holidays!

Did you know that Wanda Hunt our resident Yoga instructor is now teaching Tai Chi here at the library? Tuesdays 11 am stop in and join the group. Tai Chi has lots of health benefits from improving balance to benefiting bone density!

And don't forget Chair Yoga, Mondays at 2 pm, the fee for this class as well as Tai Chi is only one, non-perishable food item for the Richfield Springs Food Pantry.
