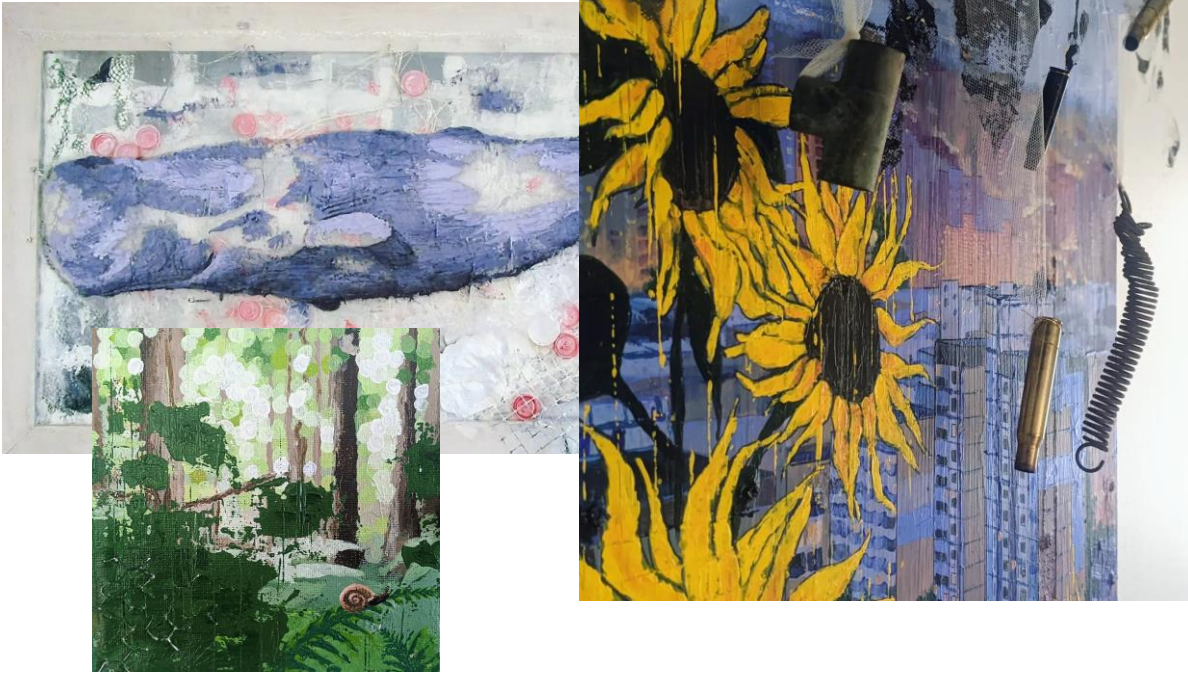

Elise Zvirzdin's artwork will remain in the library through part of March, if you haven't seen her work yet, stop by and check it out.

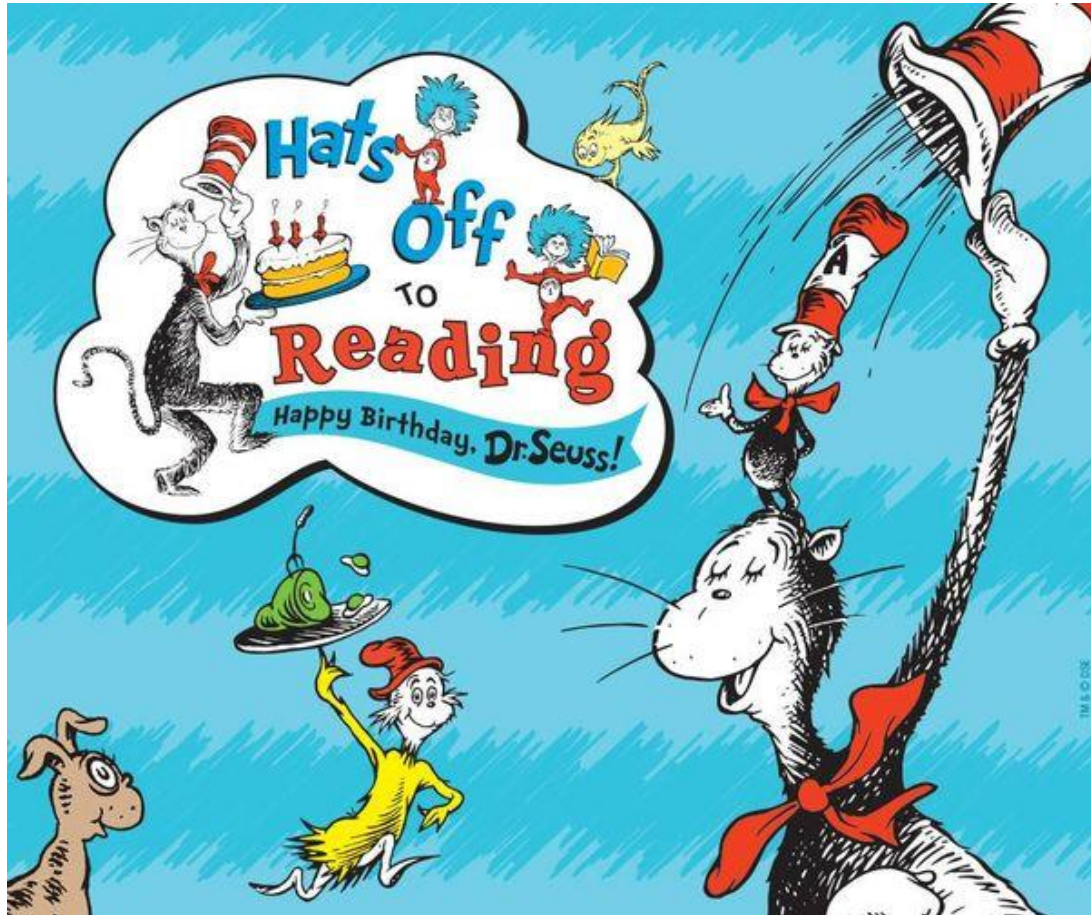
Richfield Springs Village Election Day is March 19th all day. The election will take place in the Memorial Room of the Library. Attendants will be available for assistance.
