

SMYRNA PUBLIC LIBRARY WIRELESS NETWORK ACCESS POLICY

The library's wireless connection is not secure, therefore any information being transmitted could potentially be intercepted. Wireless users should choose not to transmit personal information (credit cards, passwords or any other sensitive information) while using any wireless

access.

Library staff cannot troubleshoot problems related to your wireless device or assist in making changes to your device's settings and/or hardware configuration. The library cannot guarantee that your device will work with the library's wireless access points.

The library will not be responsible for any personal information that is compromised, or for any damage caused to your hardware or software due to electric surges, security issues or consequences caused by viruses or hacking.

If you need to print, you may save your work to other media or email files to yourself, then login to a wired library workstation and send jobs to the public printer. Princh program allows printing from your device through our staff computer with the help of the librarian.

All patrons are expected to use the library's wireless access in a legal and responsible manner, consistent with the research and informational purposes for which it is provided.

Use of the wireless network is entirely at the risk of the user. The library disclaims all liability for loss of confidential information or damages resulting from that loss.
