Official HONOREE Guidelines:

Applications Requirements

In order to be considered for a banner, the Honoree must meet the following requirements:

- Lived in New Berlin, South New Berlin, Columbus, Pittsfield, NY at some time during their life.
- Presently serving or has served in one of the following branches:
Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, Space Force, to include Reserve, and National Guard
- Honorably discharged, OR missing in action OR died during their time of service

Banner Design, Time Frame and Location

Banners are of vinyl material, approximately 24 x 48 with the photograph and printing visible on both sides. They include the service person's name, photograph, branch of service, years of service, or conflict in which they served. The banners will be displayed annually from Memorial Day through Veterans Day.

Your favorite and best quality Honoree photograph, preferably in uniform, is to accompany this application form. This photo can either be delivered, mailed or emailed.
