Telephone Numbers

Missing Person (Infant, Child, Adult)

- Dial 911 to report emergency and location
- Secure all exits
- Verbally detain any who:
 - Is accompanied by a child
 - May be concealing a child
 - Fits the description of the missing person
- Do NOT physically detain anyone!
- Notify the Library Director or Board President

If Question of Fire Suspected R.A.C.E.

Notify Town Supervisor

Dial 911 to report emergency and location

Rescue
Rescue anyone in immediate

danger

Notify Library Director
Alarm Dial 911

Notify Board President Confine Confine the fire by closing doors

and windows

Extinguish Use extinguisher or blanket to

or smother if fire is small

Evacuate If you cannot extinguish the fire

Fire Extinguisher Use

Pull The safety pin

Aim The nozzle at base of fire Squeeze The handles together

Sweep Back and forth at base of fire

● Fire● Explosion● Visible Smoke● Carbon Monoxide

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Take Action

- Dial 911 to report emergency and location
 - Keep patient calm and quiet
- Notify Library Director or Board President
- Notify Town Supervisor

If Trained

- Airway
 - Make sure airway is not obstructed
- Breathing
 - Perform ventilation as needed
- Circulation
 - Perform chest compressions as needed
- Stabilize patient

Medical Emergency

Threat of Terrorism

Look, Listen, Think

- Look for suspicious items or packages
- Look for anything out of place
- Look for unusual sights
- Listen for unusual founds

Do Not Touch Anything Unusual; Do Not Start a Search

Await the arrival of the police

Declaration of Emergency

- Dial 911 to report emergency and location
- Notify Library Director or Board President
- Notify Town Supervisor

● Threat of Terrorism ● Bomb Threat

Violent or Threatening Behavior

Active Shooter

Violent Action not involving Firearm

- Physical altercation
- Threats of violence
- Weapons that are not firearms
- Dial 911 when safe

Declaration of Emergency

- Dial 911 to report emergency and location
- Establish safety zone
- Stay away
- Secure area
- Protect others
- Notify Library Director or Board President
- Notify Town Supervisor

Active Shooter

- Display or use of firearm
- Threat of active shooter

Declaration of Emergency

- Assist others with the following
- Evacuate, if safe to do so
- Run away from the direction of threat. Advise others to leave with you, but don't stop if they refuse.
- Hide (shelter in place)
- Take action (last resort)
- Dial 911 when safe
- State "Active Shooter", your location, and location of shooter(s)
- Notify Library Director
- Notify Board President
- Notify Town Supervisor
- Violent or Threatening Behavior
- Active Shooter

ADVERSE WEATHER

ADVERSE WEATHER will be declared when the National Weather Service issues a Severe Weather Warning for the immediate area.

- Tornado
- Wind
- Hail
- Rain/Severe Thunderstorm
- Flooding
- Severe Snowstorm

If adverse weather is declared:

- Consider closing library
- Shelter in place if weather prevents people from leaving the building
- Notify the Library Director or Board President

UTILITY FAILURE

No Electricity

- Close the library
- Call the Town Supervisor
- Call the Board President

No Water

- Close the library
- Call the Town Supervisor
- Call the Board President

No Heat

- Close the library
- Call the Town Supervisor
- Call the Board President

No Internet

• Call Steve Bachman at 4CLS

Utility Failure

Property Damage

Break-In

- Close the library
- Do not touch any evidence (screw drivers, crowbars, etc.) and preserve for police
- Call 911
- Request police report
- Call the Town Supervisor
- Call the Board President

Property Damage

- Close the library
- Do not enter damaged library
- Call 911
- Request police report
- Call the Town Supervisor
- Call the Board President

Insurance Claim

Work with Board to assess damage and submit insurance claim

- Break-In
- **Property Damage**
