EXHIBITS

The William B. Ogden Free Library invites artists to exhibit their work in the designated meeting room of the library facility. Artist must agree to the following:

1. Artwork must hang from the exhibit rail and will remain on display for approximately one month.
2. The artist will assume total responsibility for installing the exhibit. No additional nails may be used in the walls. Similarly, the artist is responsible for the removal of the exhibit. A schedule for set up and removal of the exhibit must be arranged with the Director.
3. The artist assumes full responsibility for the artwork exhibited. All items are placed in the Library at the owner's risk. Neither the William B. Ogden Free Library nor the Village of Walton shall assume any responsibility or obligation for any loss or damage to any item or items displayed. The displayed items are not covered under any insurance policy owned by the Library or the Village.
4. Prices for any artwork may not be posted. Artist contact information may be provided so that patrons may contact the artist if they are interested in purchasing artwork off premises.
5. Admission fees may not be charged.
6. Artists will not be reimbursed for exhibiting.
7. Artist must complete, sign, and date an Art Exhibit Release Form.
