Teams have been named and T-shirts are being created. The competitions will be held on April 21st for 3-5th graders and May 4th for 6-8th graders

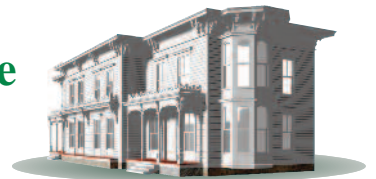
