Also included on the website are a variety of Summer Reading Lists.

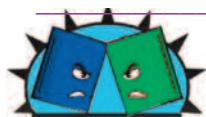

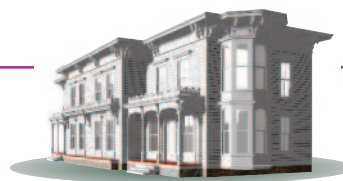

The Library is pleased to announce our new Project Manager, Glenn Jaquish (*building manager at Worchester School*), who is helping us make real progress. Building permits have just been acquired so construction can start. The first phase is to remove the siding to insulate and sheath the walls; replace with new siding; and install new windows. We are very grateful for Glenn’s assistance—could not do it without him.
