State Library Aid was increased this year by an additional \$1M for a total of \$96.6 M.

Also the State Public Library Construction Aid was increased to \$34 M from \$24M.

Only 25 libraries nationwide received this award.

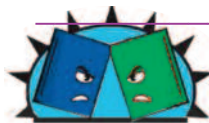
