Worcester and Schenevus schools have their teams and the list of books to read is set. The full collection of the books are at the library to check out.

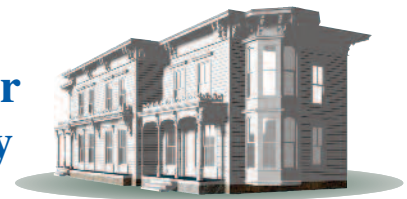
Thursday Book Club
