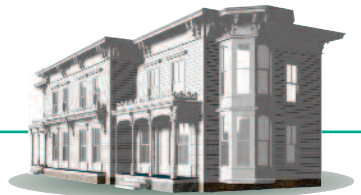
Crafter's Circle
